When you export QuickBooks data to Excel, the resulting file will be in either the .xls, .xlsx, or .csv file format. (In this case, you will likely get a .csv file.) If your class is using Quick Grader, you must submit an .xlsx file or the autograding will not work. To change the file format in desktop versions of Excel (2007 and higher), choose File—Save As and change the Save As Type to Microsoft Excel (*xlsx). In the online app, when you choose File—Save As, the .xlsx file format is applied by default. Always pay attention to the format of exported files and resave to .xlsx when necessary. You won't always be reminded.
