Using Dashboard

- Widgets are small application programs that perform tasks for you
- Some programs are helper applets, such as Address Book
- Adding, configuring, and removing Widgets
- Manage Widgets with Widget Manager
- Finding new Widgets

Using iTunes

■ iTunes Features

- iTunes menus
- Toolbar (volume control, display, views, and search field)
- Library, Store, and Playlist sidebar
- View pane shows tracks, radio stations, videos, and iTunes store items
- Status bar with buttons to add playlists, shuffle, repeat, artwork, burn, Genius and hide

- iPhoto features
- Importing photos
- Editing photos
- Creating slideshows and QuickTime movies
- Creating calendars, books, and cards
- Sharing photos

- Creating a project
- Adding photos, video clips, and music
- Previewing and saving the movie project
- Modifying the movie project
- Export the movie

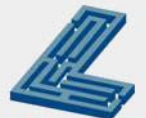


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
